The greater protection has been obtained thanks to a total reengineering of the CXP-HD™ foam technology that provides cushioning for exercise and sports play. Gerflor's Taraflex® Evolution continues to be the market benchmark in sports floors with outstanding durability, improved comfort and protection offering a P1 category shock absorbency (25% to 35% compliance with 14904) and a 7.5mm thickness.

Similarly, Sports Hall 2 at Bangor University now benefits from 675m2 of Gerflor's Taraflex® Comfort sports flooring. Taraflex® Comfort is the first Taraflex® sports floor in the P3 category (it complies with EN Standard 14904) delivering ≥45% of shock absorption and is ideal for a variety of sport and leisure activities. Offering the highest level of shock absorption, minimising the force of impact on the body, and reducing long term injury risk, Taraflex® Comfort is also available in 20 colours and three wood-effect designs as standard. Taraflex® Comfort was the first sports floor in the P3 category delivering high levels of technology and innovation knowledge to bring optimal comfort and safety and is suited to all levels and all sports for all users regardless of their age and sporting ability.
